

LUND WATERWORKS DISTRICT.

BY-LAW NO: 22.

A by-law to fix a charge for Capital Expenditures on Multiple Occupancy Developments on parcels of land within the District.

WHEREAS it is considered that due to future and continuing multiple occupancy developments occurring within the District, it will be necessary at a future date to enlarge mains, close loops, or to otherwise in any way augment the capacity of the works of the District to ensure an adequate water supply within the District; and

WHEREAS it is considered that the costs of the said enlarging of mains, closing of loops or otherwise in any way augmenting the capacity of the works of the District to ensure an adequate water supply within the District, shall be borne by persons developing land within the District:

The Trustees of Lund Waterworks District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. In addition to the provisions of the Multiple Occupancy Water Regulations By-law, being By-law No: 21 of the District, each and every applicant shall pay a charge of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00 ^{plus costs}) for each and every unit in his proposed multiple occupancy development prior to its being approved by the Trustees of the District.
2. All sums of money collected under this by-law shall be deposited in a special Trust Account, separate from all other funds of the District, and deposits in such special Trust Account, plus all interest or earnings thereon shall be disbursed only by a Resolution of the Trustees of the District which has been given the written approval of the Inspector or Deputy Inspector of Municipalities.
3. This by-law may be cited as the "Multiple Occupancy Capital Expenditure Charge By-law."
